GENERATIVE AI POLICY

OUR POLICY

Large Language Models (LLM) or Generative AI usage is strictly forbidden throughout the BathMUN 2025 conference. LLM and Generative AI refers to a group of technologies including, but not limited to, ChatGPT, Grok, Perplexity, DeepSeek, Claude, Copilot, and Meta AI.

LLM or Generative AI usage can be described as:

- Accessing LLM or Generative AI, including web-accessed LLM or Generative AI, during the conference.
- Or, using LLM or Generative AI to generate pre-written materials including position papers and security directive.
- Or, using LLM or Generative AI to generate speeches, to generate content for speeches, to generate Working Papers or their content, to format Working Papers, to amend Working Papers, to generate Draft Resolutions or their content, to format Draft Resolutions, to amend Draft Resolutions, to generate Directives or their content.

If a delegate is found to be using AI during the BathMUN 2025 conference, the committee Dais' will warn delegates of breaking this policy. Under the Dais' discretion, they will pass this information to the BathMUN secretariat.

If a delegate, after repeated warnings, is found to break this policy, the delegate will be ineligible for BathMUN 2025 awards. If a delegate is a member of a delegation, the BathMUN Secretariat will contact the necessary Head Delegate and Faculty Advisor for an appropriate warning.

In the most extreme cases, the BathMUN secretariat will remove the delegate from the conference and the delegate will be blacklisted from future BathMUN conferences in any capacity.
